All levels have divisions within (i.e. A, B, C, etc). Students will be promoted when they have properly learned and applied all of the elements in the curriculum necessary to that level/division. Promotions may be made at any time during the year, according to the teacher's discretion, based on her more than 35 years of teaching experience.

## Classwear

*\*All classes/levels: No jewelry, except stud earrings*

*\*No legwarmers or other warm up attire, except dance sweater, if necessary*

*\*Girls should always wear a shirt & shorts or pants (not their dance skirt) over their leotard  
& tights when arriving at/leaving the studio*

### Ballet Girls

- 1) Leotard, any solid color (no cutouts/keyholes, mesh, halter or spaghetti strap leotards or printed images/designs)
- 2) Nude camisole leotard underneath for added thickness, replaces underwear

*Note: All undergarments must be hidden under the leotard. If physically necessary, bras/liners are required and must be completely covered by the leotard or shirt. Nude colored, no-show through bras are available through Dance Trends. Racerbacks, t-backs and halters are*

*visible outside of leotards and therefore are not permitted.*

- 3) Lt. pink/ballet pink convertible tights, worn under the leotard
- 4) Finger-tip length single or double-layer soft ballet skirt w/ elastic waist (no tutus or long skirts)
- 5) Pink leather full-sole ballet shoes
- 6) Hair pulled back away from the face and secured in a bun with bobby pins; no headbands

### Levels 4-6 Ballet Girls will also need:

- 1) Black mid-knee to calf-length character skirt (available at Dance Trends)
- 2) Black character shoes (1"-1 1/2" heel)
- 3) Contact the teacher for demi-pointe & pointe shoe recommendations



### Ballet Boys

- 1) Solid color T-shirt (no print), tucked in
- 2) Knee-length, elastic waist shorts (basketball shorts, e.g.)
- 3) Socks
- 4) Black leather full-sole ballet shoes
- 5) Long hair must be pulled back and secured

### Level 4 Ballet Boys will also need:

Black character shoes (available at Dance Trends)

### Tap Girls

Same as ballet (with ballet skirt or soft knit shorts or soft knit capri-length pants)  
Black leather full-sole lace-up oxford style shoes  
Hair in a bun



### Tap Boys

- 1) Solid color T-shirt (no print), tucked in
- 2) Knee-length, elastic waist shorts (basketball shorts, e.g.)
- 3) Socks
- 4) Black leather full-sole lace-up oxford style shoes
- 5) Long hair must be pulled back and secured
